#### **Results:**

Our thanks to **794 KRCB volunteers** for their helping hands and great enthusiasm in completing the following

projects:

The Graffiti Eradication Team used **20** gallons of paint to eradicate graffiti **200** tags along the Riverside Canal at Tyler St. and Shoshone Ave.

The Storm Drain Cleanup Team removed litter and debris from **14 storm drains** in the Downtown Neighborhood in Ward 1.

Volunteers planted **50 trees (Chinese Fringe, Crape Myrtle, and Redbud)** along
Alessandro Blvd. in Ward 4 as part of our
Arbor Day Celebration

Volunteers collected **over 14,000 lbs.** of litter, green waste and bulky items at **38 locations** in seven Council Wards and six Business Councils throughout the city.

Clean Campus Competition: (April 1 – 30) 18 Schools from Alvord Unified School District, Riverside Unified School District and Private Schools completed 356 beautification projects with an estimated 5,570 volunteers. Clean Campus Competition volunteers collected 13,060 lbs. of litter, recycled 498 bins of recyclable

products and **planted 1,128 plants** to beautify their campuses.
