The Graffiti Eradication Team used 40 gallons of paint to eradicate graffiti 280 tags behind Nichols Park.

Volunteers planted 17 trees (Redbud Forest Pansy) along Polk Ave. in Ward 6 as part of our Arbor Day Celebration
