## Litter • Graffiti • Illegal Signs • Abandoned/Junk Vehicle • Outside Storage Scoring Key

LITTER		GRAFFITI	
<b>1</b>	<b>No Litter</b> - virtually no litter can be observed	<b>1</b>	<b>No Graffiti</b> - virtually no graffiti can be observed
<b>2</b>	<b>Slightly Littered</b> - small amounts of litter can be observed	<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal Graffiti</b> - one or two small instances of graffiti; no larger than 6x6 feet
<b>3</b>	<b>Littered</b> - visible litter can be seen throughout the sub-area	<b>3</b>	<b>Moderate Graffiti</b> - long swatches, or combined amounts of graffiti of approximately 12 feet long
<b>4</b>	<b>Extremely Littered</b> - a continuous amount of litter is the first thing noticed in the sub-area	<b>4</b>	<b>Predominate Graffiti</b> - graffiti is seen continuously; the site may require equipment and a crew to remove

  

ILLEGAL SIGNS		ABANDONED/JUNK VEHICLE	
<b>1</b>	<b>No Illegal Signs</b> - no signs can be observed	<b>1</b>	<b>No Abandoned/Junk Vehicles</b> – no abandoned or junk vehicles
<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal Illegal Signs</b> – roughly 1-5 illegal signs can be observed	<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal Abandoned/Junk Vehicles</b> – 1 abandoned or junk vehicle
<b>3</b>	<b>Moderate Illegal Signs</b> – 6-10 illegal signs are visible	<b>3</b>	<b>Moderate Abandoned/Junk Vehicle</b> – 2-3 abandoned or junk vehicles
<b>4</b>	<b>Predominate Illegal Signs</b> – 10+ illegal signs are visible	<b>4</b>	<b>Predominate Abandoned/Junk Vehicle</b> – 4 or more abandoned or junk vehicles

### OUTSIDE STORAGE

<b>1</b>	<b>No Outside Storage</b> – No openly stored items
<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal Outside Storage</b> – 1-4 openly stored items that look untidy; cleaned up in an hour with 1-2 people
<b>3</b>	<b>Moderate Outside Storage</b> – Items openly stored that could fill a small shed approximately 8' by 10'
<b>4</b>	<b>Predominate Outside Storage</b> – Items that would fill one car garage approximately 10' by 20'
