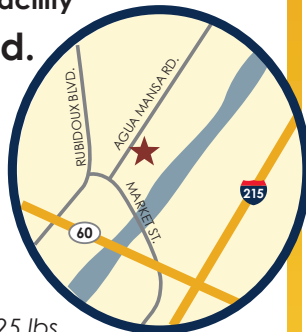

March 16 & September 21, 2019

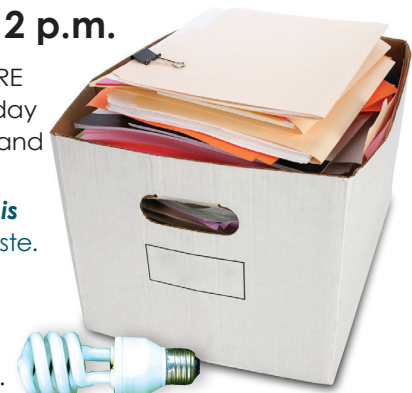

Sample Container

It's unlawful to put medical sharps such as hypodermic needles, lancets, pen needles etc. into curbside collection recycle or trash containers.

Sharps must be sealed in a sharps disposal container or a hard-sided PLASTIC container such as a bleach or laundry detergent bottle with a secure lid. Containers must have a label that states "Biohazard".
