Enclosed are your instructions and guidelines for this year's Clean Campus Competition. We have three different projects for students to learn about litter prevention, recycling and beautification.

- Prepare three reports and submit to KRCB by April 30th.
- Judging to take place week of May 3rd.
- The Clean Team - organize a team of students to do a litter cleanup as needed in the areas listed below:
 1. Athletic Field
 2. Bike Rack Area
 3. Graffiti
 4. Hallways or Walkways (on campus)
 5. Lunch Area
 6. Parking Lot
 7. Playground
 8. Sidewalks (outside perimeter)
 9. Streets Surrounding School
 10. Trash Bin Areas
- The Green Team - create or improve recycling efforts in your school within the areas below:
 1. Paper
 2. Plastic
 3. Aluminum
- Campus Beautification Team - concentrate on one or more areas of your school to improve the beautification of your campus.
 1. Plant trees
 2. Create flower beds
 3. Build a planter
 4. Composting
 5. Any ideas that students may have to beautify the school

The Clean Team - Instruction Sheet

- Assemble a team of students for the Clean Team (any amount.)
- Divide your campus into 10 areas:
 1. Athletic Field
 2. Bike Rack Area
 3. Graffiti
 4. Hallways or Walkways (on campus)
 5. Lunch Area
 6. Parking Lot
 7. Playground
 8. Sidewalks (outside perimeter)
 9. Streets Surrounding School
 10. Trash Bin Areas
- Take “before photos” of the 10 areas listed above and label each photo with the name of the area, and add to report.
- Use the Clean Team Report Form provided and judge the amount of litter at each location on a scale of 1 to 4 before you do your cleanups.
 - 1 = No Litter – virtually no litter can be observed
 - 2 = Slightly Littered – small amounts of litter can be observed
 - 3 = Littered – visible litter can readily be seen throughout the sub-area
 - 4 = Extremely Littered – a continuous amount of litter is the first things noticed in the sub-area
- Clean the 10 areas and take “after photos.” Label each photo with name of area, and add to report.
- Set a goal to establish an annual schedule to maintain the cleanliness of your campus throughout the year.
- Contact KRCB 951-683-7100 to make arrangements to pickup supplies for your cleanup. (Gloves, Trash Bags or other supplies needed for your cleanup)

The Green Team - Instruction Sheet

- **Your school may already have a recycling program in place. If so, these ideas may help improve on your program. If not, initiate a recycling program using the following recommendations.**
- **Assemble a team of students for the Green Team (any amount.)**
- **Select an area(s) on your campus to initiate a recycling program (example – classrooms, lunch area, playground or an area of your choice.) Make a Map and distribute to all students to acquaint them with the “recycling areas” on campus.**
- **Start a program for recycling paper, plastics, and aluminum. Be creative... use boxes and label. Add more recycling containers to your campus as needed.**
- **Form a team to collect recyclables on a weekly basis and take to the designated area of your campus. Separate your paper, plastic and aluminum.**
- **Take photos of each recycling container and add to report.**
- **Fill out the report form.**
- **Ideas to go Green:**
 - **Organize and conduct an aluminum can drive as a fundraiser**
 - **Read books on recycling to classrooms**
 - **Promote a contest the “Best Recycling Classroom”**
 - **Schedule an Environmental Awareness Assembly**
 - **Research how recyclables are turned into renewable sources**
 - **Organize and create a recycle game**

 - **Place planters along walkways**

 - **Start an indoor garden, plant seeds and transfer to garden**
