Every year KRCB conducts a Community Appearance Index Judging Tour. The purpose of the judging tour is to monitor and track litter, graffiti, illegal signs, abandoned/junk vehicles and outside storage trends throughout the City of Riverside. Results from the CAI are used as research for prevention programs within our schools, public awareness, and KRCB Beautification projects throughout the year.

Judges are comprised of KRCB Staff, KRCB Advisory Board Members, city employees, and the community (optional). Judges will score up to five (5) sub areas in all of the seven (7) Riverside council wards. The sub areas are up to one mile and consist of the following locations: residential, mall/shopping center, school, park and business district. The following charts provide an individual breakdown of litter, graffiti, illegal signs, abandoned/junk vehicles and outside storage in the seven Wards and the five sub-areas in each of them.

<b>Litter Metric Key</b>	
<b>1</b>	<b>No Litter</b> - virtually no litter can be observed
<b>2</b>	<b>Slightly Littered</b> - small amounts of litter can be observed
<b>3</b>	<b>Littered</b> - visible litter can be seen throughout the sub-area
<b>4</b>	<b>Extremely Littered</b> - a continuous amount of litter is the first thing noticed in the sub-area

# Community Appearance Index 2024 Graffiti Index

## Graffiti Metric Key

- 1** No Graffiti - virtually no graffiti can be observed
- 2** Minimal Graffiti - one or two small instances of graffiti; no larger than 6x6 feet
- 3** Moderate Graffiti - long swatches, or combined amounts of graffiti of approximately 12 feet long
- 4** Predominate Graffiti - graffiti is seen continuously; the site may require equipment and a crew to remove

<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal Illegal Signs</b> – roughly 1-5 illegal signs can be observed
<b>3</b>	<b>Moderate Illegal Signs</b> – 6-10 illegal signs are visible
<b>4</b>	<b>Predominate Illegal Signs</b> – 10+ illegal signs are visible

### Outside Storage Metric Key

| <b>2</b> | <b>Minimal Outside Storage</b> – 1-4 openly stored items that look untidy; cleaned up in an hour with 1-2 people |
| <b>3</b> | <b>Moderate Outside Storage</b> – Items openly stored that could fill a small shed approximately 8’ by 10’       |
| <b>4</b> | <b>Predominate Outside Storage</b> – Items that would fill one car garage approximately 10’ by 20’               |
