Results:

Our thanks to **754 KRCB volunteers** for their helping hands and great enthusiasm in completing the following projects:

The Graffiti Eradication Team used **43 gallons of paint** to eradicate graffiti next to the Olivewood Cemetery in the Ward 3 neighborhood. **Over 200 tags** were removed, restoring **120 square feet** of wall.

The Storm Drain Cleanup Team removed litter and debris from **40 storm drains** in the Downtown Neighborhood in Ward 1.

Volunteers planted **30 Trees (Black River Birch, Common Hackberry, Western Redbud, and California Pepper)** at Loring Park in Ward 1 as part of our Arbor Day Celebration

Volunteers collected **over 10,220 lbs.** of litter, green waste and bulky items at **47 locations** in seven Council Wards and six Business Councils throughout the city.

Clean Campus Competition:

28 Schools from Alvord Unified School District, Riverside Unified School District and Private Schools completed **781 beautification projects** with an estimated **19,068 volunteers**. Clean Campus Competition volunteers collected **19,360 lbs. of litter, recycled 1,256 bins** of recyclable products and **planted 695 plants** to beautify their schools.
